Our Treasurer, Matt Haverson presented the accounts and explained it had been necessary to review subscription rates. It has been decided to amalgamate the termly subscriptions and weekly payments and in order to cover increased running costs, subscriptions will be £20 for Club days and £10 for the Communications Group with effect from 1 June. All members will receive an individual letter by the end of April setting out exactly what amount is to be paid.
